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
\mathcal{O} ur \mathcal{V} ineyards...

We source our fruit from select vineyards in Oregon and Washington.

... IN OREGON

In Oregon, we prefer the coastal areas of the Willamette and Rogue Valleys given the cooling influences of the Pacific marine layer.

The Willamette Valley, Oregon's most well known AVA, extends from south of Portland for 100 miles and encompasses 5200 square miles flanked by The Coastal and Cascade Mountain ranges. This region's perpetually mild climate allows the Pinot family of grapes to ripen slowly with the benefit of the cool Pacific air.




The Rogue Valley, located in Southern Oregon, is 70 miles wide by 60 miles long and encompasses both the Applegate AVA and Illinois Valley. The Applegate's warmer climate and higher elevations ranging from 1000 to 1500 feet make it an excellent place for growing Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Chardonnay and Syrah. The Illinois Valley with even higher elevation greater than 2000 feet is the coolest, steepest and highest part of the region creating a macroclimate suitable to cooler climate varieties like Gewürztraminer, Pinot Gris, Pinot Noir and Riesling.

...IN WASHINGTON

The fruit for our Washington wines comes from the Columbia Valley, a dry region east of the Cascade Range. The Columbia Valley is Washington's largest viticultural region, covering almost 11 million acres or about 1/3 of Washington state. 99% of wine grapes grown in Washington State are from the Columbia Valley.

Our wineyards are planted on predominately south-facing slopes, increasing solar radiation in summer and promoting air drainage in winter. We source from several AVA's within the Columbia Valley including the Wahluke Slope and Horse Heaven Hills.



Wahluke, which means "watering place", was named by the North Americans who settled there. It is an 81,000-acre region located in the center of the Columbia AVA featuring more than 20 vineyards. It was recognized as an official AVA in 2005.

Horse Heaven Hills is a range of rolling hills which was once home to large bands of wild horses. It, too, was established in 2005 and borders the Yakima AVA on the north and the Columbia river in the south. Elevations there range from 1800 to 2000 feet above sea level and the strong winds serve to protect the vineyards from rot and fungal disease.

We are a family owned wine business headquartered in Hood River, Oregon, which is home to a great collection of wineries, breweries and outdoor activities including water and snow sports.

We love our work, and the opportunities it provides us to live and play in the Columbia River Gorge area. We can say we honestly know what wine to serve with grilled Salmon and Steelhead (Naked Pinot Noir) as Dave Michalec provides the meal on a regular basis.



On the mountain David Barringer and many of employees teach skiing/snowboarding and know that our Pinot Gris is the perfect way to start the Aprés Ski.

As for Jody, she's regularly leading the family on hiking adventures and Outdoor Vino is the light weight reward for achieving the summit.
